J SGT Tech Tips

Toyota Remote Common Programming Problems

The purpose of this month's tech tip is to shed some light on the ongoing issue of programming Toyota Remotes . The SGT Tech team have compiled

some background information, tips & tricks to ease some of the frustration.

Toyota's that won't go into programming Mode

Check that with the key in the ignition and the driver's door is open that the key reminder chime is present (audible beep). If there is No Chime it could be 1-of-3 scenarios.

1.Door Switch issue

If there is **NO** chime > Check that the instrument cluster shows that the door is OPEN.

If there is **NO** indication on the cluster than check that the wire is connected to the door switch. (Often the customer will disconnect this to stop

the chime). If the wire is connected swap the

switch with the passenger side door to see if this resolves the issue. 2.**Key reminder switch issue**

If there is No chime > Check that the

instrument cluster shows that the door is open.

If there is an indication on the cluster that the door is OPEN, check to see if moving the key up and down triggers the chime to come on intermittently. On some models it is not uncommon for the ignition barrel to become worn out enough that the key does not make contact with the key reminder switch all the time.

Try to hold the key in a position that it makes contact enough to complete the programming method.

If moving the key Up & Down doesn't trigger the chime , check that the key reminder switch is Plugged In (Often the customer will disconnect this to stop the chime)

3.Blown fuse

A blown fuse can often affect multiple systems on a vehicle.

Toyota's that go into programming Mode that won't accept another remote.

If the vehicle is going into programming mode but will not accept a remote it could be 1-of-3 scenarios

1. Wrong Remote Selection

If the wrong remote is selected the vehicle will not accept it and therefore will give No response to it in the procedure. Ensure you have the right remote selected and verify using the SRS.

2.The Space for storing remotes is FULL

After completing the remote programming procedure the door locks Cycle Twice instead of Once to indicate the Remote Memory is Full. Redo the procedure turning the IGN on twice instead of Once at step 7 ((Toyota procedure 1 -on SRS Option 7b.)

This will clear all the Remotes and Add in any New remotes at the same time.

3.KEYDIY ISSUE

We have found that some KEYDIY remotes require the LOCK & UNLOCK to be held for 1.5 secs, than Both the LOCK & UNLOCK to be held again for another 1 second.
